All Aboard Giveaway Rules

No purchase necessary to enter or win. Open to legal U.S. adult residents residing in the U.S.

HOW TO ENTER: To enter, complete an official entry form at Trainfest 2019 and deposit it in an assigned receptacle. Or, send a 3"x5" card with your name, mailing address, street address, city, state, zip, mobile phone number, and email address in an envelope to All Aboard Giveaway, P.O. Box 242, Butler, WI 53007-0242. Entrant waives all claims for lost, late, illegible or misdirected entries or for any problems of technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer equipment, software, failure of any postal or email service and/or any combination thereof, including without limitation any damage to entrant's or any other person's computer resulting from participation in this contest. All entries become the property of the WISE Div. of the NMRA and Trainfest.
